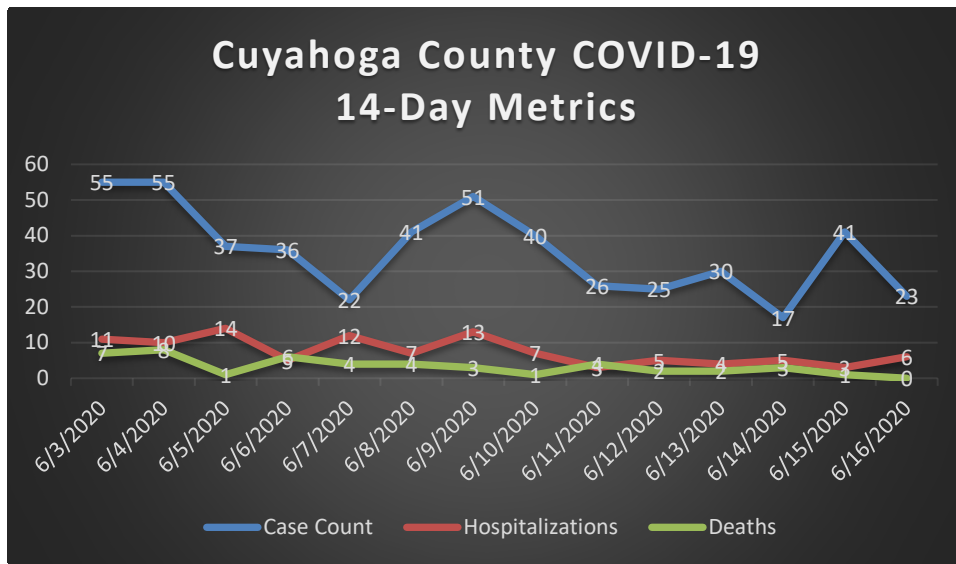
CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

This week during the City Council meeting we discussed the fact that Cuyahoga County continues to be a leader in the state in infection rates and that the zip codes covering Cleveland Heights continue to be hotspot for the virus. There are many factors contributing to these numbers, most of which are not made available to us in order to protect highly sensitive medical information of individuals, but many have speculated about our area being home to many healthcare workers as well as our County's demographics. I have added an additional chart to illustrate the per capita rates for case counts, hospitalizations, and deaths as a result of the coronavirus for the four largest counties in the state. Although Franklin County has nearly 82,000 more residents than Cuyahoga, we have the same number of deaths per capita and a higher hospitalization rate. Statewide, there have been 42,422 cases, adding 6,072 new cases since last week. 7,051 people have been hospitalized across the state and 2,611 Ohioans have

died as a result of the virus as of this writing. We will continue to monitor these metrics which are available on the State’s coronavirus.ohio.gov website on the dashboards page.
